


Student Complaint Process

Leeward Community College recognizes its responsibility to provide students with an informal process for addressing concerns about faculty treatment of students that are not protected by academic freedom and are not covered by other procedures. Examples might include ineffective or inefficient service (i.e., not replying to email inquiries in a timely manner, such as 48 business hours), or neglect of duty (i.e., not providing a syllabus, not holding office hours, not returning a graded assignment/exam before the next similar assignment/exam is due, not having an up-to-date gradebook). To address these concerns, below are the steps students should take to resolve such issues.

Student Complaint Process



Step 1: Contact your instructor regarding your concern via email, phone, or in-person.



Step 2: If the concern is still unresolved after 48 business hours, contact the Division Chair or Unit Coordinator.
